Main areas of study:	Through play the children will be invited to think all about themselves. (Dosbarth Meithrin Bore starts at 9am and Dosbarth Meithrin Prynawn at 1pm). • Go to the library to find stories together that you can share - extra points if they are topic based - tell us about it! • Talk, talk, talk - don't forget the importance of talking to your child. • Sing songs you know, sing silly songs, make up your own silly songs together - the sillier the better! Ask them what they've sung in school.
