I am writing to inform you that a vacancy has occurred for a Parent Governor for your child's school and you are invited to submit a nomination for the post of Parent Governor.

Any parent of a registered pupil at the school, at the time of the election, is eligible to be a Parent Governor and to hold office for four years even though your child may leave the school in the meantime.

If you are eligible and wish to be nominated as a Parent Governor, you should complete the form overleaf.

The completed form should be returned to the box provided at the school, not later than Friday 25th March 2022 **Please note it is your responsibility to ensure that the nomination is placed in the box.**

If there are more nominations received than the number of vacancies for Parent Governors, then an election will take place. Voting papers will be sent to all parents with children at the school.

With effect from September 2013 the Welsh Government require all new governors to attend a mandatory induction training session within twelve months of taking up the post. The session will last approximately two hours and be provided, free of charge, by the Local Authority School and Governor Unit. Additional, voluntary training courses for governors are provided free by the Authority and information is also circulated from time to time regarding courses arranged by outside bodies, for which a fee may be payable.
