

## Reception 45 High Words - Reading and Writing

By the end of Reception children are expected to be able to read these high frequency words. Some of these words can be sounded out using phonic sounds learnt in RWI, however many need to be learnt by sight reading.

Every child learns at their own pace and not all children will be able to read these words by the end of the year, however having a go every day starting from the top of the list and working your way down will help your child to learn how to read. These words can also be used for daily handwriting practice.
