Class: Reception

Term: Autumn

Theme: Celebrations

Main areas of study:	<p>Our topic this year will focus on different types of celebrations including Harvest, Diwali, Guy Fawkes, Hannukah and Christmas. We will look at the importance of these celebrations, the different religions, the different ways in which these are celebrated, the different foods that are eaten and any other important features. At the end of term, we will plan and design our own celebration and we will have lots of fun celebrating this in class.</p> <p>We will also be introducing the important phonics work using Read, Write, Inc. Children will learn all the initial sounds and then we will move on to blending to improve the children's reading. A parent session for Read, Write, Inc will take place at the beginning of 2024.</p> <p>Our mathematics work will focus on numbers, and we will be working on counting, number recognition, comparing, sorting and addition and subtraction.</p>

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<p>Ways in which you can help at home:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Please talk to your child about any important celebrations/religious events within your family. If you have any special objects/photos that you would like to share with the class, then please bring them in. ▪ We would welcome in any parent or family member with any knowledge or expertise of any special celebration within your family. If there is any skill or food/cooking that could be shared with the class, then please let us know. ▪ We will start sending home reading books in the next few weeks. Please ensure that you read frequently with your child and return their book on their allocated reading day. Flashcards will also be sent home to help with some of the words in the books. ▪ PE day is every Monday – Please could children wear their gym kit to school on this day, we recommend shorts/joggers or leggings, t-shirt, jumper and trainers. ALL long hair must be tied back, and ALL jewellery removed including stud earrings.
<p>Ways you can help us?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Please could you label all your child's belongings including jumpers, lunchboxes and water bottles. ▪ Please make sure your child brings a coat/jacket to school everyday. ▪ If anything happens in school and we feel that you need to be informed about this, we will speak to you directly. If there is anything you need to raise with us, please do so either in person or through Class Dojo messages.
<p>Behaviour Policy</p>	<p>We use positive praise and class rewards to promote positive behaviours. The children decide on the class golden rules at the start of the year, and we always refer back to these.</p> <p>For pupils behaving inappropriately, sanctions will include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Time out on the Thinking spot • Loss of part of Golden Time
