We will be sending home a sunflower for you to nurture and grow at home. We would love to see photos of the sunflower growing.</li> <li>Please talk to your child about healthy eating and maybe even prepare food/meals together.</li> <li>We will continue to send home reading books and flash cards. Please can you read at home with your child and return their book on their allocated reading day.</li> <li>PE day is every Monday – Please could children wear their gym kit to school on this day, we recommend long trousers or leggings, t-shirt, jumper and trainers.
