Parent's Guide to Online Learning at Burlais Primary School

The majority of online work will be set via Class Dojo.
 It is VITAL that you sign up to this system so that you can access the work set. If you haven't yet signed up then please contact the school office on 652350 and provide your email address and mobile number. Your child's teacher will then send you an invite to join.



- 2. In addition to Dojo, older pupils in Years 4, 5 and 6 will have their own logins to access HWB. The pupils have been shown how to access TEAMS and some work will be set through this platform. If your child has forgotten their login details, contact your teacher via Dojo for help.
- 3. Younger pupils have also been provided with workbooks that should be home that contain daily activities such as handwriting, High Frequency Spelling words etc.
- 4. Teachers will set work weekly with a wide range of activities. These activities can be completed in any order.
- 5. In addition to these activities there is also a **Daily Do Box** that needs to be covered daily. These include activities such as reading with your child, number bonds, times tables practice, handwriting etc.
- 6. If you do not have access to digital equipment, then please contact the school office so that we can arrange to loan you some equipment.
- 7. If your child attends Rapid Reading in school they will have a log in that they can use to access it from home. If they have lost the login please contact the class teacher via Dojo.
- 8. Teachers are expecting work to be completed daily by the pupils and will be monitoring completion of work through TEAMS and Dojo. Don't let your child fall behind!
- 9. There are some great websites that can help you with home learning. Here are a few to help you -

www.oxfordowl.co.uk - There is a help sheet on the website to help you access this so that you can use the same reading scheme that we use in school.

<u>www.whitrosemaths.com</u> - This can help you go over maths concepts easily plus there are worksheets and videos to explain it all www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize - This can be helpful for all pupils and covers all aspects of the curriculum

- 10. As a school we have decided not to deliver live lessons as part of our remote learning policy. Some classes may have some video introductions or set missions via video and again these will be shared via TEAMS or Dojo.
- 11. Paper copies of work can be arranged in advance if there is an issue with online working. These will have to be requested in advance via Dojo so that the office staff can photocopy them for you. They can be then collected from the school office at a predetermined time.
- 12. If you have any problems with online learning then contact your class teacher via Dojo or the HWB platform, or contact the school office so we can forward your query onto them.



13. Well-being is really important to both you and your child. It is a challenge trying to juggle your work load and teach your child at the same time.

Remember little and often is best.



14. If you want to share pictures of projects that you have undertaken with your child e.g. gardening projects, cooking activities etc. then send them to your class teacher via Dojo and we can share them with the rest of the class
