Term: Autumn

Theme: Enterprise

<p>Main areas of study:</p>	<p>Our topic for the Autumn term is <i>Enterprise</i></p> <p>In Languages, Literacy, and Communication: In English, we will be learning the features of a persuasion writing text type. We will also focus on oracy skills, reading behaviours, spelling, punctuation and grammar. In Welsh, we will be recapping familiar language patterns, developing reading and oracy skills, and writing 1st person profiles, 3rd person profiles, and past tense.</p> <p>In Mathematics & Numeracy: Money, profit, loss, working out the best value for money and applying our use of financial literacy across the curriculum. We will learn about place value, rounding, data handling and the four operations of number.</p> <p>In Humanities: We will focus on business studies this term. We will locate businesses across Swansea and The Gower, locating areas within the city. We will conduct market research and make links to our Enterprise theme.</p>
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	<p>In Science and Technology: We will focus on chemistry this term. We will learn about the states of matter, investigate changes to state and introduce pupils to the periodic table of elements.</p> <p>In Expressive Arts: In Expressive Arts, we will be refining skills using water colours. Within music, we will be listening to Carl Jenkins' Adiemus. Learning about film and digital media.</p> <p>In Health & Well-being: In PE, we will focus on invasion games, dance and gymnastics.</p> <p>LNF & DCF: This topic is built on application of skills across the curriculum, and our learners will have many opportunities to apply the skills they have acquired this year during the topic.</p>
