Term: Summer

Theme: Enterprise - making and selling products

<p>Main areas of study:</p>	<p>Our topic for the Summer term is <i>Enterprise</i></p> <p>In Languages, Literacy, and Communication: In English, we will be learning the features of a persuasion writing text type. We will also focus on National test practice, oracy skills, reading behaviours, spelling, punctuation and grammar. In Welsh, we will be recapping familiar language patterns, developing reading and oracy skills with outdoor learning.</p> <p>In Mathematics & Numeracy: Money, profit, loss, working out the best value for money and applying our use of financial literacy across the curriculum. We will learn about angles, shape and solve multi-step word problems.</p> <p>In Humanities: We will focus on geography and business studies this term. We will locate businesses across Swansea and The Gower, locating areas within the city. We will undertake a geography investigation and conduct market research making links to our Enterprise theme.</p>
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	<p>In Science and Technology: We will focus on biology this term, learning about plants, animals, and living organisms. We will investigate survival and competition within living organisms.</p> <p>In Expressive Arts: In Expressive Arts, we will be using a range of artistic styles in our Leaver's assembly production i.e. performance, drama, dance, singing. We are also focussing on film / digital media.</p> <p>In Health & Well-being: In PE, we will focus on athletics and the skills used to compete within this in preparation for Sports Day. We will also focus on Rounders skills.</p> <p>LNF & DCF: This topic is built on application of skills across the curriculum, and our learners will have many opportunities to apply the skills they have acquired this year during the topic.</p>
