Wonderful

World

During the Spring term, our topic is What a Wonderful World which focusses on the 7 New Wonders of the World.

In *Languages, Literacy, and Communication*, the pupils will learn about Discussion texts and Persuasion texts. The pupils will write their own stories using story maps to sequence their ideas.

Main areas of study:

In *Maths & Numeracy*, the pupils will learn about length and capacity, money, fractions, decimals and percentages, temperature and negative numbers, perimeter and area, time and co-ordinates.

In *Humanities*, the pupils will learn about the Seven New Wonders of the World and where they are located using globes, maps, atlases and Google Earth. They will learn about religious beliefs of countries around the world.

In **Science and Technology**, the pupils will learn about plants around the world. They will investigate what conditions plants need to grow. They will learn how to create and sort databases and how to create spreadsheets using formulae. The pupils will design and build models of the Seven New Wonders using different

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	materials and using Minecraft Education.
	In <i>Expressive Arts</i> , the pupils will learn to appraise music from around the world and use Chrome Music Lab and percussion instruments to create their own dramatic music. They will also create art work based on the Seven New Wonders using a variety of different medium. The children will learn different dances from around the world. In <i>Health & Well-being</i> , the pupils will participate in many Circle Time lessons to discuss emotions and well-being. The pupils will enjoy a range of P.E lessons including Hockey, Lacrosse and various Team Games. The pupils will apply their Literacy skills to produce a leaflet to persuade people to visit one of the Wonders of the World. They will also write a discussion
	text about the Wonders of the World. They will also apply their Maths & Numeracy skills in their topic work. Finally, the pupils will use their digital skills to create PowerPoint presentations and learn about databases and spreadsheets using Microsoft Excel about the Wonders.
