Main	In Languages, Literacy, and Communication - English - Persuasion text type, letter writing, grammar, poetry, instruction text type, and Spanish with Pentrehafod.
areas of study:	In Languages, Literacy, and Communication - Welsh - Past tense writing, role play, speaking and listening and <i>third pers</i> on sentence patterns.
	In Maths & Numeracy - Money and profit and loss; perimeter, area and volume (geometry); decimals and percentages; temperature and negative numbers; ratio; applied numeracy skills across the curriculum through our topic and theme.

	In Humanities - Welsh and global economies, governance of Wales and the wider world, poverty and inequality, the history of broadcasting including TV, radio, and digital media.
	In Science and Technology - chemistry, design and technology and product design.
	In Expressive Arts - digital media, printing, drama, and advertising.
